## **BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES**

The Champlain Parkway will provide improved bicycle and pedestrian facilities along the entire corridor. A new, shared-use path will connect Pine Street to the existing shared-use path at Home Avenue. New, continuous, and ADA-compliant sidewalks will be installed and bike accommodations will be included on roadways. The new and upgraded traffic signals will have pedestrian WALK signals and include a pedestrian phase. The project has also been designed to protect mature trees where feasible, further improving the pedestrian environment.

Existing sidewalks throughout the study area are narrow, inconsistent, and in disrepair.





In the MAPLE AND KING STREET NEIGHBORHOOD, inconsistent, broken, and narrow sidewalks will be replaced with 5-foot ADA-compliant sidewalks. The new sidewalks will have wheelchair ramps and crosswalks. Each intersection will have a WALK phase timed into the traffic signals. There will be painted sharrows leading to on-road bike lanes south of the neighborhood.







There will be on-road bicycle accommodations along the entire project corridor.



The shared-use path will be extended from Home Avenue to Kilburn Street.



New and upgraded traffic signals will include an exclusive pedestrian phase with WALK signals, giving pedestrians a safe time to cross with no vehicular traffic moving through the intersection.
